The Board met in session at the Linn County Jean Oxley Public Service Center.
Present: Chairperson Walker and Vice Chairperson Rogers. Absent: Supervisor Zumbach
(personal business). Board members voting "AYE" unless otherwise noted.

Chairperson Walker called the meeting to order.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Walker to approve minutes of August 9, 2021 as printed.

The Board heard updates from the following Department Heads:

Brad Ketels, County Engineer - KPI's; budget status; GIS position was an offer submitted - trying to create using their own funding, bring to the Board soon; FEMA update regarding debris removal; DayForce and GovSense software updates; one vacancy; revising access policy; construction project updates; general maintenance (blading, seal coating, etc.).

Tom Hardecopf, LIFTS Dir. - one bus will be delivered shortly with two more remaining; budget status; one part time vacancy; federal TSA mask mandate still in place; LC3 meeting this week; current ridership is 60% of pre COVID numbers; Electric Bus Work group continues to meet; successful ADA celebration on July 30th.

Motion by Rogers, seconded by Walker to appoint Ann Hearn to the ADA Advisory Committee retroactive to July 1st for a term ending June 30, 2024.

Darrin Gage, Dir. of Policy & Admin. - highlighted a PowerPoint for The American Rescue Act Plan of 2021 that he will be presenting at the public engagement forums.

Supervisor Rogers stated that he received an email from a constituent that is opposed to wearing masks. He will not be putting it on file due to there being lots of expletives in the email. Rogers is proud of the steps the Board has taken. The Board will discuss medical or religious exemptions at the Board meeting tomorrow.
