RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TSIP) FUNDING FOR THE INTERSECTION OF IOWA HIGHWAY 100 AND SOUTH 31ST STREET TO CONVERT THE 2-WAY STOP CONTROLLED INTERSECTION TO TRAFFIC SIGNALS WITH TURN LANES.

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation has established the TSIP and provides funding for locations where vehicular safety is a concern and documented.

WHEREAS, the Iowa Highway 100 and South 31st Street intersection has been identified as a location where vehicular safety could be improved and funded by TSIP.

WHEREAS, the improvements installing traffic signals with turn-lanes will help reduce crashes and improve traffic operations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LINN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, that:

1. The Board of Supervisors supports the application for TSIP funding.
2. The Board of Supervisors hereby commits the additional County funds necessary for the construction of the project beyond any TSIP funding as per County jurisdictional limits.
